

NYU@NUS PERMISSION TO INCREASE/DECREASE CREDIT LOAD

The typical credit load for NYU@NUS LL.M. students is 10 NYU credits in Summer Term and 2 NYU credits in Winter Term. Students are permitted to take only one course in each Teaching Block during the Summer and Winter Terms. Students may take one additional course in the Summer Term (i.e. in one Block only they may take two courses), and another additional course in the Winter Term with the permission of the program director. Students are strongly discouraged from taking two 3-credit courses at the same time. Students who register for more than one course at the same time without the permission of the program director will be dropped from at least one course.
