

REQUEST TO AUDIT INTRODUCTION TO U.S. LAW

If you have a degree from a U.S. law school or have previously taken a comparable course (and have been approved for a waiver), you cannot register for Introduction to U.S. Law. However, you can audit the course, which means you must attend every class and prepare the work *as if you were enrolled for credit*. As an auditor, you will not be required to sit for the exam, and you will not receive credit for the course.
