



## **What is the Weinfeld Program?**

The Weinfeld Program was instituted in 1989 by the New York University School of Law as a way to honor the legacy of one of the Law School's finest alumni, Judge Edward Weinfeld (1911-2001). The Program recognizes alumni and friends whose generosity exemplifies Judge Weinfeld's extraordinary dedication and commitment to the Law School. With a membership of more than 1,000 members, the Weinfeld Program is the NYU School of Law's most prestigious donor recognition group.

## **Why join the Weinfeld Program?**

The growth and success of the Weinfeld Program has played a critical role in meeting the Law School's ongoing needs and has been responsible, in large part, for the significant advances in legal education the Law School has made over the last several years. By providing critical funding, members of the Weinfeld Program support student financial aid, most importantly scholarship, the law library, institutional research, student journals, and organizations.

The Law School provides special occasions for members of the Program to meet throughout the year to network and celebrate the Law School's accomplishments. Members are invited to a variety of unique programs, which include distinctive events focused on legal education, social gatherings, and receptions for visiting dignitaries.

In recognition of their commitment to the Law School, the names of Weinfeld members are prominently displayed on the Weinfeld plaque in Vanderbilt Hall, listed in the Weinfeld Directory, and are recognized in the Law School's *Annual Report of Donors*. Additionally, each year the Law School honors the members of the Weinfeld Program at a gala black-tie dinner, which has become the signature Weinfeld event.

## **How do I join the Weinfeld Program?**

Alumni and friends may join by making an annual commitment to the Weinfeld Program. Weinfeld Benefactors make annual gifts of \$20,000 or more; Weinfeld Patrons make annual gifts of \$10,000 or more; Weinfeld Associates make annual gifts of \$5,000 or more; recent graduates join as Weinfeld Fellows with annual gifts of \$1,000 until they have celebrated their 10<sup>th</sup> Reunion; and current students may become Weinfeld Fellows by making a gift of any size prior to graduation and pledging to give at the Fellows level for at least two years following graduation.
