PERMISSION TO INCREASE/DECREASE CREDIT LOAD

To register for (or drop below) fewer than 12 credits, or for more than 15 credits, students must obtain approval from the Office of Graduate Affairs via a Credit Load Permission form. Please note that full-time LL.M. students who register for more than 30 credits will incur charges in addition to the flat rate charged each semester. The Law School requires all full-time students to register for a minimum of 10 credits per semester to maintain full-time student status. There are no exceptions to this minimum. If a student is approved for fewer than 12 credits in a semester, a full-time equivalency will be placed on the student's record, and the student will be responsible for full-time tuition.

It is especially important for international students to note that in accordance with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), all international students must be registered for the fulltime program within two weeks of the start of *Intro to U.S. Law*, or if they have waived out of *Intro to U.S. Law*, within two weeks of the first day of classes of the Fall semester. For the Spring semester, students must be registered full-time within two weeks of the start of classes.
