OUTLaw is particularly invested in the struggle for racial justice in the United States, given the fact that the vast majority of anti-LGBTQ hate crimes are against people of color (almost 90% of anti-LGBTQ homicide victims in 2013, with a startling 67% of victims being transgender women of color) as well as the reality that when these victims fight back, they are often imprisoned for doing so. We proudly join the community of NYU Law students advocating for accountability within this legal system that we are all training to enter. OUTLaw remains open to engage in further discussions and advocacy efforts with respect to these important issues.
