- 2. Incentive Funding Request – Media Law Collaborative** **Alana Broad, Julie Amadeo**
 - a. Seeking support for Fashion Law Conference on February 19th, 2015

- 3. Incentive Funding Request – Iraq Refugee Assistance Project** **Katie Goswer, Alex Zetes**
 - a. Provide legal representation for people in the Middle East seeking resettlement, usually somewhere in the Middle East. Will be sending 5 students to Aman, Jordan in early January. Students meet with NGO's and intergovernmental organizations, and is a way for students to learn about refugee law and to bring back important skills and enthusiasm for this issue.
 - b. Received \$1275 from SBA and Prominence Fund chose to match that funding. Lexis has agreed to give \$500.
 - c. *Why is the trip in January instead of March like it was last year?* IRAP set the date.
 - d. *If the group doesn't get the money, what happens?* Costs will be out of pocket for participants, and this will limit the people who apply.
