- + **New Student Group Proposals:**
 - Law Students of Catan (LSoC): The Group's goal is to host weekly game nights, workshops and build bonds based on the game. The Group will provide an alternative study break and a tournament a year. Recognition of the Group is crucial for reserving spaces at the law school and for now, is not requesting a budget. The SBA members voted and approved (Y-17, N-0, A-0).

The Critical Reading Group will host bi-weekly meetings with professors and students, as an organized activity with guided discussions and reading. The Website will provide a forum and book review system for commenting on scholarship. The SBA members voted and approved (Y-15, N-0, A-2).
