# About the Fellowship

The three NYU Fellows will join select Ford grantee organizations in fall 2014 in staff attorney positions for one year or to staff specific one-year projects. The Fellowship carries a \$45,000 stipend. The Ford Foundation will additionally reimburse up to \$15,000 of the host organization's costs for benefits.

The fellowship program is a part of the Ford Foundation's Social Justice Fellowships Initiative. This program supports summer and post-graduate public interest fellows from NYU School of Law, Harvard Law School, Stanford Law School, and Yale Law School.

To apply, 3Ls should submit:

- Resume;
- Cover letter that addresses the student's commitment to social justice, leadership experience, and experience relevant to, and match with, the organization and position/project; and
- Commitment letter from the sponsoring organization that addresses the mission of the
  organization, how the proposed project/position supports that mission, the
  qualifications/experience of the Fellow's supervisor, and how the organization will support the
  Fellow.
