Public Interest and Government Contacts: PILC can connect you with potential speakers who work in public interest and government for your events and programs. If your student group is planning an event with outside guests, feel free to email <u>pilc.info@nyu.edu</u> for assistance and guidance on reaching out to them.

Publicity: PILC can help publicize your student group event by including it in the PILC portion of the weekly Docket email to students. Be sure to submit the announcement to PILC at <u>pilc.info@nyu.edu</u> on the Wednesday before the week you'd like the announcement distributed on the Docket.

Guidance: PILC is available to act as a sounding-board for your program ideas. We've worked with many student groups before and are able to provide you with advice for your event ranging from how to reserve the right space for your event to deciding on an event agenda.
