FALL 2017 RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY MAKE-UP SCHEDULE

According to the academic calendar approved by the faculty, classes are not suspended on religious holidays. Nonetheless, we know that many people (students and faculty) may be observing the same. Of particular interest to some may be the following religious holidays during fall 2017:

- Eid al-Adha- Thursday, August 31* (evening) & Friday, September 1*
- Rosh Hashanah Wednesday, September 20 (sundown) & Thursday, September 21
- Yom Kippur Friday, September 29 (sundown) & Saturday, September 30 No direct class impact.
- * These are projected dates.

If you intend to cancel one or more classes in observance of the Muslim holiday of Eid al-Adha or the fall Jewish holiday of Rosh Hashanah, please adhere to the following assigned days and times in which to make up your class. Note no make-up schedule has been created for Yom Kippur as this holiday occurs on a day and time when no classes would be directly affected.

By strictly adhering to this fixed make-up calendar, it is possible to avoid make-up class conflicts for students that would otherwise occur. Classes have been assigned to make up their class using the Friday afternoon make-up block, as this day has sufficient minutes.

For those who do not cancel class, consistent with the Law School's general policy, audio recording is available whenever there is reason to believe a significant number of students might be absent. If you would like your classes audio-recorded for students who will be observing the Eid al- Adha or Rosh Hashanah holidays, you may schedule the recording via NYU Classes. Instructions on how to schedule a recording of classes can be found <u>here</u>.

CAVEAT:

Except for Friday, September 8, and Friday, September 15, we did not designate a make-up class during the Friday morning make-up block <u>from 8:00-9:50 am</u> as we are reserving this time for make-up classes due to faculty illness, emergencies or conferences. (NOTE: When we used the early morning make up blocks we started later in the morning. If you prefer, you can start your make up class at 8 am and only have one session.)

If you plan to schedule a make-up class, please have your assistant reserve your currently scheduled room as soon as possible, but no later than August 28, 2017. Please keep in mind that the make-up class you schedule may meet for a shorter or longer time than the make-up block (1 hr. 50 min.). Please schedule your make-up class for the same number of minutes as the canceled class.

Please note that for classes which meet for a longer time than the scheduled make-up block allows, you may either schedule the make-up class to go longer than 3:50 p.m. (provided the classroom will be available for the extra time) or you may schedule two make-up classes.

Please keep in mind that there may be classroom changes in the summer during the registration period. Therefore, before classes begin in late August, please have your assistant make certain that your make-up room is the same as the room to which we have assigned to your class.
