If you need assistance, call (212) 998-2222 or ask a Department of Public Safety guard on patrol around NYU. The Department of Public Safety has a radio-equipped patrol car that cruises the campus 24 hours a day. Look for the white car with the amber light that says "New York University Public Safety" in purple lettering on the side.

Transportation – NYU Campus

NYU campus transportation services (NYU trolleys, shuttle buses and vans) are free and available for the safety and convenience of NYU students, faculty and staff. They operate from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Monday through Friday and from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday. There are stops at major residence halls and at 715 Broadway for service to Washington Square. A valid NYU ID is required for boarding these vehicles. Schedules for all routes are available at the NYU Information Center, Shimkin Hall, 50 West Fourth Street. NYU Department of Public Safety also provides “safety rides” between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, and 2:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. Students should call the Department of Public Safety at (212) 992-VANS (992-8267) to request a ride. Students living at 240 Mercer Street also may check with the Law School Housing Office about setting up a late night walking group.
