Morgan Lewis is therefore proud to present the Morgan Lewis Foundation Diversity Scholarship through the Morgan Lewis Foundation (ML Foundation). We strive to promote diversity in the legal profession, thereby strengthening the profession and improving its contributions to our communities.

ABOUT

Established in 2014, the ML Foundation, an independent 501(c)(3), uses funds awarded to Morgan Lewis in a historic settlement on behalf of African American families working to combat nearly a century of government-sponsored racial segregation in the Baltimore area. The organization has awarded close to \$2 million in scholarship funds to promising law students.

AWARD

The ML Foundation Diversity Scholarship will be a gift, typically set at \$20,000 for the second year of law school and \$20,000 for the third year of law school, provided that the student remains eligible.

ELIGIBILITY

To receive an ML Foundation Diversity Scholarship, an applicant must be enrolled in New York University School of Law. The applicant must successfully complete the first year of law school, be entering the second year of law school with an anticipated graduation in 2025, and be of diverse racial ethnicity.

Directors from the ML Foundation will evaluate each applicant and consider such factors as academic achievement, financial need, work and life experiences, leadership, and non-academic contributions. The ML Foundation intends, in most years, to select one rising 2L applicant from each eligible school.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for an ML Foundation Diversity Scholarship, an applicant must submit a (1) completed application form, (2) resume, (3) personal statement, (4) law school transcript, and (5) signed Financial Eligibility Disclosure and Consent Form. Scholarship finalists will be interviewed by the ML Foundation board of directors.
