

SPRING 2026 HOLIDAY MAKE-UP SCHEDULE

According to the academic calendar, approved by the faculty, classes are not suspended on all holidays. Nonetheless, we know that many people (students and faculty) may be observing certain holidays.

In keeping with past practice, we have prepared a make-up schedule for only the EVE and FIRST day of select holidays. This schedule was created based on the spring holidays observed by the New York City Department of Education. Of particular interest to some may be the following holidays during spring 2026:

- Lunar New Year
 - Tuesday, February 17 – see the make-up schedule below
- Eid al-Fitr
 - Thursday, March 19 (sundown) – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
 - Friday, March 20 – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
- Passover:
 - Wednesday, April 1 (sundown) – see the make-up schedule below
 - Thursday, April 2 – see the make-up schedule below
- Good Friday
 - Friday, April 3 – see the make-up schedule below

Note: No make-up schedule has been created for the holidays that have no direct impact on classes.

If you intend to cancel one or more classes in observance of the spring holidays for which there is a make-up schedule, please adhere to the following assigned days and times in which to make up your class. By strictly adhering to this fixed make-up calendar, it is possible to avoid make-up class conflicts for students that would otherwise occur.

For those who do not cancel class, consistent with the Law School's general policy, please record your spring 2026 class. Observant students will follow the normal practice of accessing the recording and watching the missed class at a later time.

If you plan to schedule a make-up class, please have your assistant reserve your currently scheduled room as soon as possible. Please keep in mind that the make-up class you schedule may meet for a shorter or longer time than the make-up block. **Please schedule your make-up class for the same number of minutes as the canceled class.**

RE: Lunar New Year (Legislative Monday)

Please note that Tuesday, February 17 is a Legislative Monday. **That means we will follow a Monday class schedule on Tuesday, February 17.** If you have a Monday class that meets on February 17 and you plan to cancel that class, please follow the make-up schedule below.

RE: Good Friday

For classes in the Friday, G Block, we recommend faculty poll their students to determine what make-up date and time works best. Alternately, faculty can use the Monday or Thursday Make-Up Block (1:10pm – 2:25pm). Reminder: your make-up class must meet for the same number of minutes as the canceled class.

Notes:

- Spring Recess is from March 16 – March 20.
- For evening block, you may also poll your class for a more suitable evening time.
- If your class meets for 3 CONSECUTIVE hours, you can use the Friday, Make-Up Block (1:10pm – 2:25pm) and Friday, Make-Up Block (2:30pm – 4:30pm). Alternately, you may poll your class for a more suitable time.
