Classroom Breaks - Permutations

***1 credit class** = scheduled for 60 minutes per week (55 minutes of teaching could take a 5 minute break)

***2 credit class** = scheduled for 120 minutes per week (110 minutes of teaching and a 10 minute break)

***3 credit class** = scheduled for 170 minutes per week (165 minutes of teaching; typically two sessions; each 83 minutes of teaching and a 2-minute break). **Note on 14 week calendar: 75 minute sessions has NO breaks.**

***4 credit class** = scheduled for 240 minutes per week (220 minutes of teaching; typically two sessions; each 110 minutes of teaching and a 10 minute break)

***5 credit class** = scheduled for 300 minutes per week (275 minutes of teaching, typically three sessions; two sessions of 110 minutes of teaching each with a 10 minute break and one session of 55 minutes.)

Examples for calculating credits

1 credit = 55 minutes of class meeting time per week for 13 weeks + 2 hours of outside of class work for 15 weeks + a 50 minute final exam = 42.75 hours

2 credits = 110 minutes of class meeting time per week for 13 weeks + 4 hours of outside of class work for 15 weeks + a 1 hour 40 minute final exam = 85.5 hours

3 credits = 83 minutes twice per week or 165 minutes once per week of class meeting time for 13 weeks + 6 hours of outside of class work for 15 weeks + a 2 hour and 30 minute final exam = 128.25 hours

4 credits = 110 minutes twice per week or 220 minutes once per week of class meeting time for 13 weeks + 8 hours of outside of class work for 15 weeks + a 3 hour and 20 minute final exam = 171 hours

5 credits = 110 minutes twice per week and 55 minutes once per week for a total of 275 minutes of class meeting time per week for 13 weeks + 10 hours of outside of class work for 15 weeks + a 4 hour and 10 minute final exam = 213.75 hours
