Students currently enrolled in other graduate divisions of NYU (other than candidates for Law School dual degrees) are invited to enroll for courses at the Law School. They will need to secure permission of 1) the Department Chair or Director at the school in which they are currently enrolled, and 2) the instructor teaching the particular Law School course.

The Office of Academic Services will confirm availability of space in the class after registration at the Law School is complete. Notification of course request decisions will be sent by January 13, 2027, and late requests will be accepted until January 25, 2027.

Please note that you will be required to fulfill all of the requirements for each course, including the taking of examinations and the submission of required papers. Failure to satisfy course requirements will result in the denial of subsequent registration. All students taking Law School exams are required to use a laptop.
