APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. **Application Form**. The application form **MUST** be typed, completed in its entirety and signed.
- 2. **Transcript**. Please submit a copy of your most recent law school transcript.
- 3. **Resume.** (2-page limit).
- 4. Personal Statement. In 1500 words or less, please address the following factors::
 - a. The applicant's history of community, volunteer and/or public service; clinical or internship involvement, if any.
 - b. The applicant's ability to balance life responsibilities (i.e., personal, family, educational and job-related responsibilities).
 - c. The applicant's academic record.
 - d. The applicant's ability to overcome any form of personal adversity in pursuit of a legal career.
 - e. The applicant's intention to make future contributions to the Brooklyn community.
- 5. **Recommendation Letters.** Up to two letters of recommendation are *optional*.

Please be advised that incomplete applications will **NOT** be considered.
