

Frequently Asked Questions

- Can a student awarded full tuition be eligible to participate? No. This award goes directly to the law school for payment towards the student's tuition.
- 2. May the scholarship funds be applied to other law school costs (i.e., fees) besides tuition? No. This award goes directly to the law school for payment towards the student's tuition.
- 3. What does it mean to be "a resident of New York City"? Students must establish current residency in New York City by January 2021, when scholarship awards will be announced. One can maintain permanent residency in their home state.
- 4. Are LLM applicants eligible? No. Only law students in their first, second, or third year of law school may participate.
- Does immigration status matter?
 No. We only require students to be current residents of New York City.
- 6. Is there an age limit? Applicant must be 18 years or older.

The deadline for the 2021 applications is Friday, December 4, 2020.
