

## **FALL 2020 RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY MAKE-UP SCHEDULE – Via ZOOM**

According to the academic calendar, approved by the faculty, classes are not suspended on religious holidays. Nonetheless, we know that many people (students and faculty) may be observing religious holidays. For fall 2020 all make-up classes will be conducted via Zoom.

**In keeping with past practice, we have prepared a make-up schedule for only the EVE and FIRST day of the various religious holidays.** This schedule was created based on the fall holidays observed by the New York City Department of Education. Of particular interest to some may be the following religious holidays during fall 2020:

- Eid al-Adha- **Occurred before classes started (July 30 & 31)**
- Rosh Hashanah – Friday, September 18 (sundown) - **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT & Sunday, September 20 - NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
- Yom Kippur – Sunday, September 27 (sundown) - **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT & Monday, September 28 – See the make-up Schedule Below**

**Note: No make-up schedule has been created for the holiday of Eid al-Adha in 2020, due to this holiday occurring before fall classes begin.** The eve and first day of Rosh Hashanah fall on days that do not impact the class schedule and no Rosh Hashanah make-up days have been assigned. The eve of Yom Kippur occurs on the weekend and no make-up day has been assigned.

If you intend to cancel one or more classes in observance of the fall religious holiday Yom Kippur, please adhere to the following assigned days and times in which to make up your class via Zoom.

By strictly adhering to this fixed make-up calendar, it is possible to avoid make-up class conflicts for students that would otherwise occur.

For those who do not cancel class, consistent with the Law School's general policy, all classes are being video recorded for fall 2020. Observing students will follow the normal practice of accessing the video and watching the missed class at a later time.

Please note for classes that meet for a longer time than the scheduled make-up block allows, you may either schedule the make-up class to go longer or you may schedule two make-up classes.

Remember all make-up classes will be conducted via Zoom.
