

## **FALL 2023 HOLIDAY MAKE-UP SCHEDULE**

According to the academic calendar, approved by the faculty, classes are not suspended on all holidays. Nonetheless, we know that many people (students and faculty) may be observing certain holidays.

**In keeping with past practice, we have prepared a make-up schedule for only the EVE and FIRST day of various holidays.** This schedule was created based on the fall holidays observed by the New York City Department of Education. Of particular interest to some may be the following holidays during fall 2023:

- Eid al-Adha – **Occurred before classes started (June 28 & 29)**
- Rosh Hashanah:
  - Friday, September 15 (sundown) – see the make-up schedule below; and
  - Saturday, September 16 – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
- Yom Kippur:
  - Sunday, September 24 (sundown) – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**; and
  - Monday, September 25 – see the make-up schedule below
- Diwali
  - Sunday, November 12 – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**

**Note: No make-up schedule has been created for the holidays that have no direct impact on classes.**

If you intend to cancel one or more classes in observance of the fall holidays for which there is a make-up schedule, please adhere to the following assigned days and times in which to make up your class.

By strictly adhering to this fixed make-up calendar, it is possible to avoid make-up class conflicts for students that would otherwise occur.

For those who do not cancel class, consistent with the Law School's general policy, please record your fall 2023 class. Observing students will follow the normal practice of accessing the recording and watching the missed class at a later time.

If you plan to schedule a make-up class, please have your assistant reserve your currently scheduled room as soon as possible. Please keep in mind that the make-up class you schedule may meet for a shorter or longer time than the make-up block. **Please schedule your make-up class for the same number of minutes as the canceled class.**

\*\* For evening block, you may also poll your class for a more suitable evening time.

\*\*\* Friday, September 15 E Block classes had a designated make-up date of Friday, September 29. Due to inclement weather conditions, faculty who canceled their September 29 make-up class can re-schedule their class on Friday, November 17.
