

Full text for Figure 3: Public Company and Subsidiary Actions (FY 2010–FY 2019). For each fiscal year from 2010 through 2019, inclusive, there is a stacked bar indicating the number of actions against public companies and their subsidiaries. In 2011, there were 32 actions against public companies, 15 actions against subsidiaries, and 1 action against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 48 actions. In 2012, there were 22 actions against public companies, 17 actions against subsidiaries, and 1 action against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 40 actions. In 2013, there were 24 actions against public companies, 12 actions against subsidiaries, and 1 action against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 37 actions. In 2014, there were 31 actions against public companies, 18 actions against subsidiaries, and 2 actions against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 51 actions. In 2015, there were 29 actions against public companies, 53 actions against subsidiaries, and 0 actions against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 82 actions. In 2016, there were 46 actions against public companies, 44 actions against subsidiaries, and 1 action against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 91 actions. In 2017, there were 37 actions against public companies, 27 actions against subsidiaries, and 1 action against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 65 actions. In 2018, there were 31 actions against public companies, 39 actions against subsidiaries, and 2 actions against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 72 actions. In 2019, there were 39 actions against public companies, 53 actions against subsidiaries, and 3 actions against both public companies and subsidiaries, for a total of 95 actions.
