### **Law Alumni Association**

The Board of Directors of the New York University Law Alumni Association (LAA) was founded to strengthen alumni ties. The LAA provides social, intellectual, and professional opportunities for graduates. Dedicated to connecting alumni to the Law School by supporting educational and social programming and volunteer opportunities, the Board also partners with the Offices of Admissions, Student Services, and Career Services to assist with efforts in areas such as recruitment and orientation. The Association organizes virtual and large and small scale events for alumni including the LAA/ LACA Public Interest Law Center (PILC) Benefit, Moot Court Board Young Alumni Reception, and networking events.

### **Membership Criteria**

Qualities considered important for election to the LAA Board include:

- Interest in furthering the LAA's mission of connecting alumni to the Law School.
- Active engagement in activities of the Law School as a student or alumnus/a.
- Strong, proven leadership and service to the Law School or the legal profession.
- Ability to work well individually and as part of a team.

### **Responsibilities of Membership**

LAA Board members are expected to fulfill the following responsibilities to the best of their ability:

- Attend all meetings of the Board. The Board meets via video conference five times per year; when possible, meetings are held on campus in the evenings and typically last 60-75 minutes.
- Attend events sponsored by the Association.
- Participate actively on at least two LAA committees.
- Contribute annually to the Law School at a level based on the member's personal circumstances.

### **Term of Office**

Directors are elected to a four-year term. Directors may be eligible for re-election following a one-year hiatus at the close of their term.

Nominations must be submitted by **December 10, 2020**. Nominations received after this date will be considered for membership the following year.
