
REQUEST TO WAIVE *INTRODUCTION TO US LAW* AND *INTRODUCTION TO US LEGAL PROCEDURE*

If you are a full-time international student without a degree from a US law school, you must enroll in *Introduction to US Law* (2 credits) and *Introduction to US Legal Procedure* (1 credit). Please note that if you have a JD degree from a US Law School, you will be automatically waived out of these courses.

If you have previously taken a comparable course and feel you have a sufficient background in the US legal system and US legal education and research, you may request to waive out of these two classes. You must submit this form with attached transcript, syllabus and course description to the Office of Graduate Affairs: law.graduateaffairs@nyu.edu

Please note that international students are not eligible to apply for a waiver of Introduction to US Law after entering the US.
